IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRY FORM DEADLINE: July 23, 2008

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that his or her entry form is received in the Fair Office on or before the deadline.

- Before making entries, read **General Rules and Regulations, Standards for Conduct of Fairs and Animal Health Requirements.**
- The Rabbit Show will be sponsored by the Altamont Fair.
- There will be an Open Show and a Youth Show.
- Entrants in the Youth Show must be 19 and under.
- Only purebred rabbits may be entered.
- Exhibitors must put the breed, variety, classification, sex, entry code and tattoo on their entry form.
- Entry Fee is \$1.75 per animal.**
- You must bring your rabbits to the Fair on Monday, August 11 from 4 – 8 PM.**
- All animals must have a tattoo in the left ear.
- Only healthy animals will be allowed to enter. The Superintendent will perform a health check on all rabbits.
- Blue Seal Feed will donate feed. Please bring your own food and water dishes.
- Judging for the Open Show will start at 10 AM on Tuesday, August 12. Judging for the Youth Show will follow.
- All rabbits must be a recognized variety and meet the standard requirements of the American Rabbit Breeders' Assn. Rabbits with serious faults or disqualifications will not be eligible for awards.
- Available space may limit the number of entries allowed per person.
- All animal exhibits will close at 8 PM on Sunday. Release time will depend on weather and traffic conditions. Superintendents will announce exact time after consultation with Fair officials. You may also remove your rabbits from 10 AM to noon on Monday, August 18.**
