Horse Show Rules and Regulations

1. All ponies/horses must be registered with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America (Section A, B, C, D or Half Welsh) except for the open pony classes.
2. Entry fee \$5.00 per class.
3. Awards – ribbons only
3. Short Stirrup open to any age rider and cannot show in the Hunter classes.
4. Lead line/leading rein riders not eligible for any other classes.
5. Walk/trot riders not eligible for any other classes, except halter.
6. Approved helmets REQUIRED when mounted.
7. Proof of a negative EIA (Coggins) test and current rabies vaccination are required.
8. Refer to Department R for stall rental and grounds fee information.

EXHIBITORS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Reservations for horse stalls and tack stalls must be made in advance by calling Rose Norkus at 887-2489. Tack stalls must be rented for the entire 6 days at \$90 for the week. All stall reservations will now be assigned, subject to availability, based on the order in which the calls are received. There will be no exceptions. (Do not assume that you will automatically have a stall this year if you had one last year.)

2. The rental rate for all stalls is \$15 per day (or any part thereof) per horse. Full payment must be received at the Fair Office on or before August 6 and can be mailed to PO Box 506, Altamont, NY 12009. If payment has not been received by that date, your reservation will be cancelled, and the stall will be given to the next person on the waiting list.

NOTE: FRIDAY STALL RESERVATIONS ARE NO LONGER FREE OF CHARGE. A \$15.00 FEE IS DUE FOR ANY PART OF A FRIDAY RESERVATION.

3. You will be given a receipt for your payment, which will be your stall authorization. Payment must be in cash or check only. Make checks payable to the Altamont Fair. You will not be able to occupy a stall unless a receipt from the Fair has been provided and can be produced if requested.

4. There will be a \$5 per horse per day grounds fee for all horses trailered-in or walked-in that have not reserved a stall. The Fair Office will provide the Show Secretary with the names of those exhibitors who have paid for stalls. All others will be charged the grounds fee. This money will be collected by the Show Secretary along with the entry fee and forwarded to the Fair Office.

5. All stall renters are required to clean out their stalls. Please move the manure and bedding to directly in front of the stall to allow for easier pick-up by Fair staff. **Premium checks will be held if stalls are not cleaned-out by the stall renter and a reservation will not be accepted for next year.**

Entry Fee: \$5.00 per class

Awards: Ribbons ONLY

NO PRE ENTRY REQUIRED

All horse trailers must stop at the bottom of Gate 2 and have the Security guard radio up for an escort from infield security; **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
