It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that his or her entry form is received in the Fair Office on or before the deadline.

NOTICE <u>DO NOT</u> use the <u>FRONT ENTRANCE</u> for loading and unloading of animals or supplies.

- 1. Before making entries, read General Rules and Regulations, Standards for Conduct of Fairs, Animal Health Requirements, and IAFE National Show Ring Code of Ethics.
- 2. Only registered animals are eligible for entry in this Department. Registration papers must be available or photocopy of papers in process.
- 3. Ages of all animals in this Department will be computed as follows:
 - a. March 1st for Juniors & September 1st for Seniors in all dairy breeds.
 - b. For Herefords, Angus, & any other breed, age will be stated in each lot.
- 4. Entries are open to all competition. All entries will be received on a "First Come, First Served" basis.
- 5. Entry fee in this Department is \$5.00 per Lot (this includes Lots where more than one animal is to be exhibited in a single Lot)
- 6. Blankets to be removed from cattle at request of Superintendent.
- 7. There will be a designated area for the parking of all livestock trailers. You will not be able to park them anywhere on the hill or along the fence line by the barns.
- 8. Each exhibitor will supply his/her own feed and bedding.
- 9. Any animals competing in Group Lots must also be entered and previously shown in Single Lots.
- 10. All animals to be owned by exhibitor in Get of Sire and Dam Lots.
- 11. All animals must be shown in the ring before awards are made and ribbons presented.
- 12. No more than two premiums will be awarded to any one

exhibitor in any one lot. Ribbons shall be awarded as judged.

- 13. Animals entered in any lot will be judged against the standard type.
- 14. Animals must be in place by 3 pm on Monday.
- 15. The Exhibitor and Breeder shall be defined as follows: "Where the herd is registered in the names of different members of a family residing on one farm and where the herd is one unit, all entries may be considered as a single Exhibitor Dairy Herd and Three Best Female Lots."
- 16. Animals owned in partnership may be shown in the name of the partnership only; except that at time of entry a determination must be made that such animals will be shown in the name of one, but not both partners. The animals must be shown in the same way in the Group Lots as they are in the Open Single Lots.
- 17. Indicate on entry form the total number of animals in this Department.
- 18. All animal exhibits will close at 7 PM on Sunday. Release time depends on weather and traffic conditions but should be no later than 7 PM. Superintendent will announce exact time after consultation with Fair officials.
- 19. Appropriate nose lead must be in place when showing bulls in beef cattle lots over 1 year of age.
- 20. EXHIBITORS AND SPECTATORS ARE PROHIBITED FROM BRINGING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO THE FAIRGROUNDS. ANYONE IN VIOLATION OF THIS MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE, FORFEIT THEIR PREMIUMS AND/OR MAY BE REFUSED FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN THE FAIR.
