MAILED ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE FRIDAY, JULY 27, 2018

HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES MUST BE IN THE ENTRY OFFICE BY 2 P.M. FRIDAY, JULY 27, 2018

ONLINE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL 9 A.M FRIDAY AUGUST 3, 2018

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to assure the entry form is received in the Fair Office on or before the deadline.

PLEASE NOTE SIGNIFICANT CHANGE TO ENTRY DELIVERY:

BRING YOUR ENTRY TO THE FINE ARTS BUILDING ON SATURDAY, AUGUST 11, 2018 between 1 and 4 p.m.

Additional entries may be added to your previously submitted entry form (if you have not reached the limit of four entries) on SATURDAY August 11, from 1 to 4 p.m.

JUDGING: MONDAY AUGUST 13

1. Before making entries, read **General Rules and Regulations Standards for Conduct of Fairs**.
2. For each \$10 in entry fees, one free daily Exhibitor's Pass will be issued. For additional information on exhibitor passes please refer to the General Rules.
3. **Entry Fee per Lot is \$5 for Adult Show and NO ENTRY FEE for Junior Show.** You may exhibit a maximum of four works per exhibitor. Your check or money order should be made payable to "Altamont Fair." The Superintendent reserves the right not to accept entries that require extraordinary protection. Subject matter of art should be suitable for a family atmosphere.
4. No changes will be permitted to your entry after Friday, August 3, 2018, 9 a.m. There will no allowances for substitutions. If you are unsure of what you will be entering please **DO NOT** name the item on your entry form.
5. All entries will be exhibited in the Flower and Fine Arts

Building.

6. Open to all artists. Included in the exhibition will be oil and watercolor paintings, sculpture, photography and other mediums. (Crafts are shown in the Arts and Crafts Exhibit (Department M) at the Fair.)
7. Entries must be ready to hang (no exposed glass edges) and accompanied by a 3 x 5 card attached to the upper left back of work indicating title, your name, phone number and sale price. Sculpture not intended to hang on wall or stand-alone on floor must be accompanied by an appropriate display stand. **Artwork must be able to be hung or it will not be displayed.**
8. **Works of art must be brought to the fair Saturday, August 11, between 1 & 4 PM. Exhibits delivered after these hours will not be accepted.**
9. Works may be any size, but large works are encouraged for exhibitors who want to be noticed.
10. Works of art may be picked up from 8 to 10 PM on Sunday, August 19. Works must be picked up by Monday, August 20, between 3 & 6 PM. Artists may delegate proxies to pick up their works.
11. Winning entries will be awarded with appropriate ribbons, on the opening day of the Altamont Fair. Artists are encouraged to come to the Altamont Fair to experience the whole exhibition, as well as the Fine Arts and Flowers Exhibit.
12. The People's Choice ribbon will be presented at 2 PM on Sunday, August 19.
13. The Altamont Fair will provide reasonable security for the art exhibition. Entries will be handled with all possible care, but the Altamont Fair will not assume responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, works while in transit or on the premises.
14. No works of art made from kits, only original work.
15. **EXHIBITORS AND SPECTATORS ARE PROHIBITED FROM BRINGING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO THE FAIRGROUNDS. ANYONE IN VIOLATION OF THIS MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE, FORFEIT THEIR PREMIUMS AND/OR MAY BE REFUSED FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN THE FAIR.**
