It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that his or her
entry form is received in the Fair Office on or before the
deadline.

1. Before making entries, read General Rules and Regulations, Standards for Conduct of Fairs and Animal Health Requirements.
2. **There will be an Open Show and a Youth Show. PER ARBA, RABBITS MAY SHOW IN EITHER OPEN OR YOUTH DIVISION, NOT BOTH.**
3. Entrants in the Youth Show must be 18 and under.
4. Only purebred rabbits may be entered.
5. Exhibitors must put the breed, variety, classification, sex, lot number and tattoo on their entry form.
6. **Unless stipulated by Class, Entry Fee is \$1.00 per animal per Lot FOR OPEN SHOW, NO ENTRY FEE FOR YOUTH. For online entries, the exhibitor will have to provide the ear#, sex, variety and age of each animal to the superintendent before bringing the animal to the grounds.**
7. **You must bring your rabbits to the Fair on Monday, August 14 from 4 – 8 PM.**
8. All animals must have a tattoo in the left ear.
9. Only healthy animals will be allowed to enter. The Superintendent will perform a health check on all rabbits.
10. Feed will be donated. Please bring your own food and water dishes. **No water bottles.**
11. Judging for the Open Show will start at 10 AM on Tuesday, August 15. Judging for the Youth Show will follow.
12. All rabbits must be a recognized variety and meet the standard requirements of the American Rabbit Breeders' Assn. Rabbits with serious faults or disqualifications will not be eligible for awards.
13. Available space may limit the number of entries allowed per person.
14. **All animal exhibits will close at 7 PM on Sunday, August 20. Release time will depend on weather and traffic conditions. Superintendents will announce exact time after consultation**

with Fair officials. You may also remove your rabbits from 8A.M. to 10 A.M. on Monday, August 21.

15. EXHIBITORS AND SPECTATORS ARE PROHIBITED FROM BRINGING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO THE FAIRGROUNDS. ANYONE IN VIOLATION OF THIS MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE, FORFEIT THEIR PREMIUMS AND/OR MAY BE REFUSED FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN THE FAIR.

Rabbit Hopping Contest Rules:

1. Rabbit must be in the exhibit to participate.
2. Rabbit has to be wearing an H-style harness and be on a leash.
3. Rabbit must be at least four (4) months old. Pregnant Does and Does wearing a litter within eight (8) weeks of this competition are not eligible.
4. Rabbit cannot be touched with anything but your hands. Use of any other instrument in result in a fault. Use of feet is an automatic disqualification.
5. Rabbit must stay on course (eg., change of direction is only if the rabbit goes back over the previous jump). Handlers must walk alongside the course and not over the jumps.
6. Knocked down rails count as a fault. Multiple rails at same jump = one fault.
7. Lifting your rabbit over a jump counts as a fault.
8. Each rabbit will get to run the course three (3) times. Each run will be timed. Best run is counted. Winner is the rabbit with the least faults and fastest time.
9. Rabbit is permitted to be entered one time. A handler may run multiple rabbits.
