It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that his or her entry form is received in the Fair Office on or before the deadline

Additional entries may be added to your previously submitted entry form one day only SUNDAY, August 14, 2011, from 1 to 4 p.m.

1. Before making entries, read **General Rules and Regulations Standards for Conduct of Fairs**.
2. For each \$10 in entry fees, one free daily Exhibitor's Pass will be issued. If the exhibitor fails to present the exhibit for judging the Exhibitor's Pass will not be issued. For additional information on exhibitor passes please refer to the General Rules.
3. **Entry Fee per Lot is \$5 for Adult Show and \$1 for Junior Show.** You may exhibit a maximum of four works. Your check or money order should be made payable to "Altamont Fair." The Superintendent reserves the right not to accept entries that require extraordinary protection. Subject matter of art should be suitable for a family atmosphere.
4. All entries will be exhibited in the Flower and Fine Arts Building.
5. Open to all artists. Included in the exhibition will be oil and watercolor paintings, sculpture, photography and other mediums. (Crafts are shown elsewhere at the Fair.)
6. Art work may be offered for sale. No commission will be charged on sales.
7. Entries must be ready to hang (no exposed glass edges) and accompanied by a 3 x 5 card attached to the upper left back of work indicating title, your name, phone number and sale price. Sculpture not intended to hang on wall or stand-alone on floor must be accompanied by an appropriate display stand. **Artwork must be able to be hung or it will not be displayed.**
8. Works of art may be brought to the fair Sunday, August 14, between 1 & 4 PM. Exhibits delivered after these hours cannot be accepted.
9. Works may be any size, but large works are encouraged for

exhibitors who want to be noticed.

10. Works of art may be picked up from 8 to 10 PM on Sunday, August 21. Works may also be picked up Monday, August 22, between 3 & 6 PM. Artists may delegate proxies to pick up their works.
11. Winning entries will be awarded with appropriate ribbons, on the opening day of the Altamont Fair (August 16). Artists are encouraged to come to the Altamont Fair to experience the whole exhibition, as well as the Fine Arts and Flowers Exhibit.
12. The People's Choice ribbon will be presented at 2 PM on Sunday, August 21.
13. The Altamont Fair will provide reasonable security for the art exhibition. Entries will be handled with all possible care, but the Altamont Fair will not assume responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, works while in transit or on the premises.
14. No works of art made from kits, only original work.

People's Choice Award - \$100.00, no entry required, open to junior and adult entries.

10 Honorable Mention Awards at \$10.00 each, no entry required, open to junior and adult entries.

AGE GROUP:

- a. 7 and under

When making entries for Lots 1, 3, and 4 indicate the age group (a, b, or c.) for each Lot. Example Lot 1. Paintings, age group 7 and under would be entered as 1a.

When making entries for Lot 2. Photography, enter in the following order:

1. the number (2)
2. the type of photography (a. or b.)
3. the age group (a. b. or c.)

Example 2aa would be Photography, Black & White Film, and age group 7 and under. 2ab would be Photography, Black & White Film, and age group 8-12.

4. “Found” Art – something cool found in the city or country by the entrant.

Note: Additional prizes of gift certificates from local supporting businesses may be provided depending on donations.

2. Students should deliver their own work, if possible.
3. All work must be framed or matted and suitable for hanging.
4. Limit of two works per student per lot.
5. You will be notified by mail if you have won a prize.
6. Pick up work Sunday, August 21 between 8 & 10 PM or Monday, August 22 between 3 & 6 PM
